

The Declaration of Homestead and the Declaration of Domicile

I've been hearing about them... but I have no idea what they are?

The *Declaration of Homestead* protects the Manufactured home, located on leased land from forced sale in any legal action such as bankruptcy or lawsuits.

If you are a resident of Florida the **Declaration of Domicile** declares your manufactured home as your "domicile" in the event Medicaid is required to pay for nursing home care.

Medicaid rules, an individual is allowed to retain one home and one vehicle to receive Medicaid assistance.
